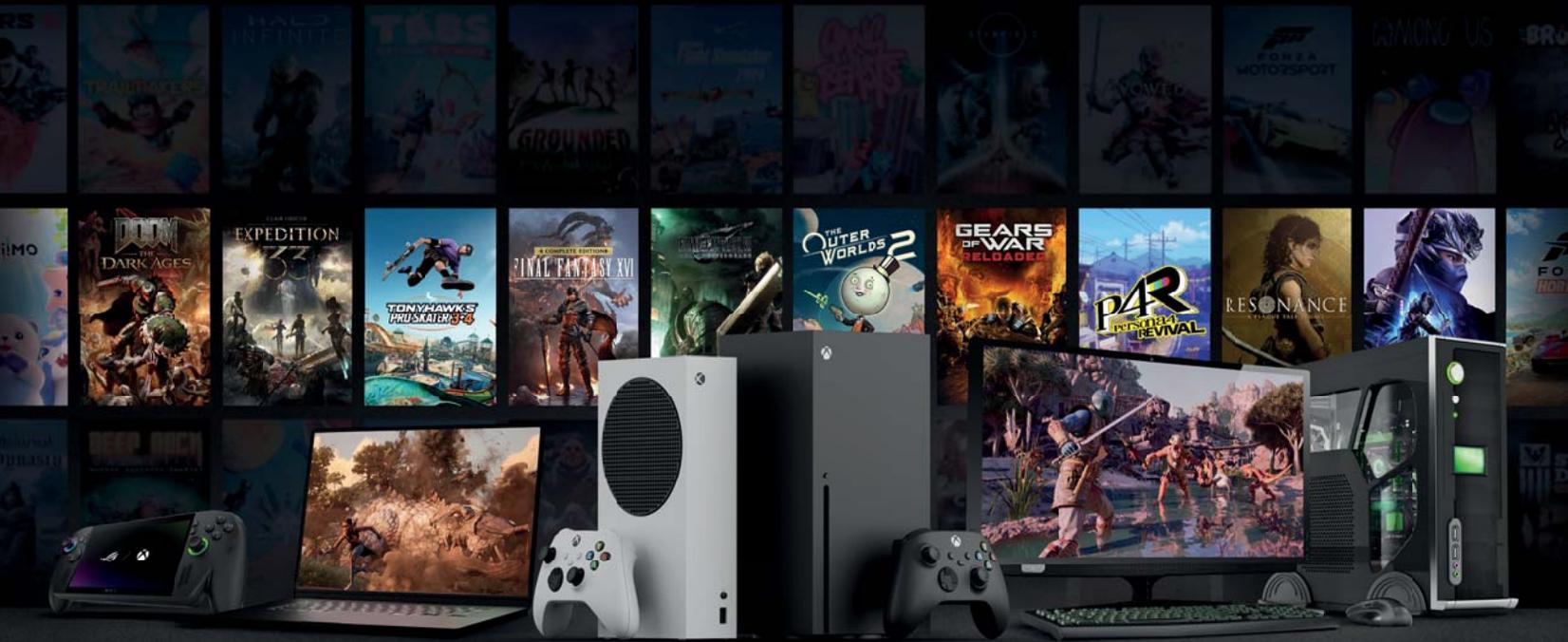

## gamescom congress connects Politics & Research

Always part of gamescom, but never as big as this year: On nine stages, the academic, cultural and political conference gamescom congress brings together all ranges of life with the games industry. The gathering ran over the course of the full Thursday at the Confex Building.

For the usual three focus topics, this year's congress featured Immersion, Responsibility and Well-Being. In these three areas as well as selected political, societal and cultural other topics, more than 150 speakers shared their knowledge.

gamescom congress is especially important for the interconnection of politics and the civil society space that connects to gaming. Politicians from Germany, the EU and the UN are commonplace on the premises and discuss their policies with the people they affect. Civil actors in turn can present their advances: Crucially, the Bertelsmann Foundation's Jessica Gerke presented their notable, extensive study on gaming behaviour in Germany.

## devcom 2025 Closes With New Record

The devcom developer conference has come to an end with another sales record at the Confex. From October 2025, the conference will officially be renamed gamescom dev. This year, 5,400 registered attendees attended the conference, representing over 2,500 companies from 89 countries. The numbers represent six percent growth since last year. On the expo floor, 53 exhibitors showcased their projects and services, including the popular devcom indie expo. "When we started devcom back in 2017, our goal was to create a home for all developers. Since then, this conference has grown into a truly global

hub for knowledge sharing, inspiration, and connection in our industry," said Stephan Reichart, MD of game events GmbH.

## Branding for House of Games Berlin Unveiled

At the first House of Games Berlin Reception at gamescom, the partners behind the project unveiled the logo and branding for the new games property in the capital, which is set to open in 2026. In addition to the House of Games Berlin logo, the slogan was also unveiled, which reads: Create. Connect. Empower. According to the project managers, the claim stands for a strong, networked gaming community that works together to find innovative solutions. The overlapping shapes in the logo symbolize development and growth – reflecting the attributes that "House of Games Berlin" will bring to the games and creative technologies industry in the capital.

## Witcher Concert Tour Debuts at gamescom

With the first stop of their Ten Years of *The Witcher 3* Concert Tour, CD Projekt Red have rocked the Event Area in Hall 1. More than two hours of original game music led the audience through a synchronised video retelling of the game's full story including all add-ons. Apart from orchestra and choir, the game's composer as well as folk metal band Percival were part of the performance.

Opening and closing the concert, CD Projekt Red PR veterans Fabian Döhla and Carolin Wendt took to the stage, reminisced on ten years of the as of yet latest Witcher game and thanked the cosplay community for their engagement around the company's games.

## Baden-Württemberg and Bavaria Party Together

Bavarian Beer and Baden-Württembergian Black Forest Cake: For the second time, the two southern German federal states have brought their politicians together for an event in the gamescom business area.

Patrick Rapp, State Secretary in the Ministry of Economic Affairs, Labor, and Tourism of the State of Baden-Württemberg and Fabian Mehring, Digital Minister of Bavaria, brought culinary gifts and promised to work together for innovation in southern Germany. Both federal states feature a strong digital economy and want to cooperate to bring more companies in.

# Nintendo Switch 2 Makes Its gamescom Debut



Nintendo presents the **Switch 2** in style. Its line-up on the show floor features a **wide selection** of both **first- and third-party games**.

**U**nsurprisingly, Nintendo's main focus at gamescom is the Nintendo Switch 2. This new console sold over

six million units worldwide within seven weeks of its 5 June 2025 release. In Hall 9.1 at stand A10/B09, visitors can try out a variety of games, take part in tournaments and enjoy other activities. First-party titles include *Metroid Prime 4: Beyond – Nintendo Switch 2 Edition* (the same demo featured at the Nintendo Switch 2 Experience in Berlin), *Pokémon Legends: Z-A – Nintendo Switch 2 Edition*, *Donkey Kong Banana*, *Mario Kart World*, *Super Mario Party Jamboree – Nintendo Switch 2 Edition + Jamboree TV*, and *Nintendo GameCube – Nintendo Classics*.

A selection of games from Nintendo's publishing and development partners is available to try out on the show

floor. These include *EA Sports FC 26* (Electronic Arts), *Hollow Knight: Silksong* (Team Cherry), *Hades II* (Supergiant Games), *Borderlands 4* (2K Games), *Elden Ring: Tarnished Edition* (Bandai Namco Entertainment), *Final Fantasy VII Remake: Intergrade* (Square Enix), and *Cyberpunk 2077: Ultimate Edition* (CD Projekt Red). Of particular note is the playable version of the long-awaited *Hollow Knight: Silksong*.

As well as trying out games, visitors to the Nintendo booth can enjoy many other experiences. Anyone who registers at the booth using their

Nintendo Account will receive an exclusive pin and 100 Platinum Points, which can be exchanged for rewards in the My Nintendo Store. There will also be daily 'fun tournaments' for *Mario Kart World*, *Super Mario Party Jamboree – Nintendo Switch 2 Edition + Jamboree TV*, *EA Sports FC 26*, and the two Nintendo GameCube Nintendo Classics titles, *Mario Smash Football* and *F-Zero GX*. ## The Show is not Over yet

Staying for the **weekend**? Business gamescom might **be over**, but the fair still has **way more to offer**. From **cosplay, social events**, and not least of all a **city-spanning festival** full of food, music, **more games** and engagement for democracy.

# W

hile the business area closes down on Friday, games-

com is fair from over. The entertainment area goes on the whole weekend, welcoming big crowds of gamers to try out new games, shop merchandise and gather goodies in giveaways and stage shows. If you want to experience the full gamescom experience, you'll have to visit the entertainment halls at least once.

### gamescom event arena

This year located in Hall 1, the event arena includes the full programme of the gamescom social stage. On Saturday, you'll find Viva La Dirt League and Piet Smiet there, including a musical surprise guest at 7pm; on Sunday, the Prime League

Offline Finale brings high-level *League of Legends* eSports.

### cosplay village

The cosplay village in hall 5.1 always warrants a visit, with plenty of amazing costumes walking around. But especially on Saturday, the heat is on, when at 5:00 o'clock the cosplay contest presented by Google will pit cosplayers in six categories against each other to find the best costumes of the fair. Whether you want to cheer for the participants or just enjoy the cosplays, it's worth a visit.

If it's too full or loud for you, don't worry: gamescom isn't just what's happening in the halls. On Saturday and Sunday, the gamescom city festival will conquer the Cologne outdoors as well.

### gamescom city festival

gamescom city festival features well-known artists, participatory formats and DJ sets packed with serious party

vibes. And once again, it's not just about the music - sociopolitical topics are also on the program.. The festival covers a huge area, from Rudolfplatz over Hohenzollernring up to Friesenplatz on the left and on Picassoplatz near the Tanzbrunnen on the right Rhine side.

Several musical main acts will pull visitors to the festival. Part of the festival is also the finale of the Arte Summer Tour, an entertainment bus full of karaoke, concerts and quiz shows. On Sunday, the city festival traditionally joins forces with the Festival of Democracy. Under the motto "Arsch Huh für Demokratie" (that's 'Lift your ass up for Democracy', but in a Cologne dialect), the main stage at Hohenzollernring will feature music, discussions, introductions of civil society organisations and much more.

A children's programme is provided both days at the Toggo Tour stage on Picassoplatz. Various food stands, a beergarden and more in the way of culinary experiences are a given as well. They open at 14:00 o'clock and close with the last of the stage programmes. If you are still in Cologne at the weekend, don't miss the festival!

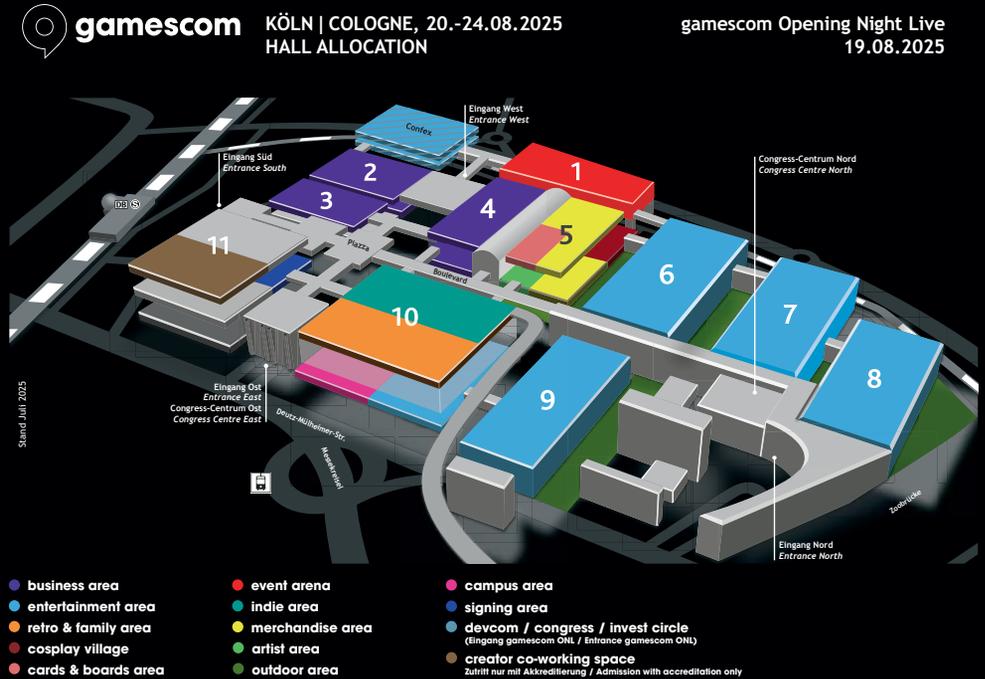


# Floor plan hall 2.1

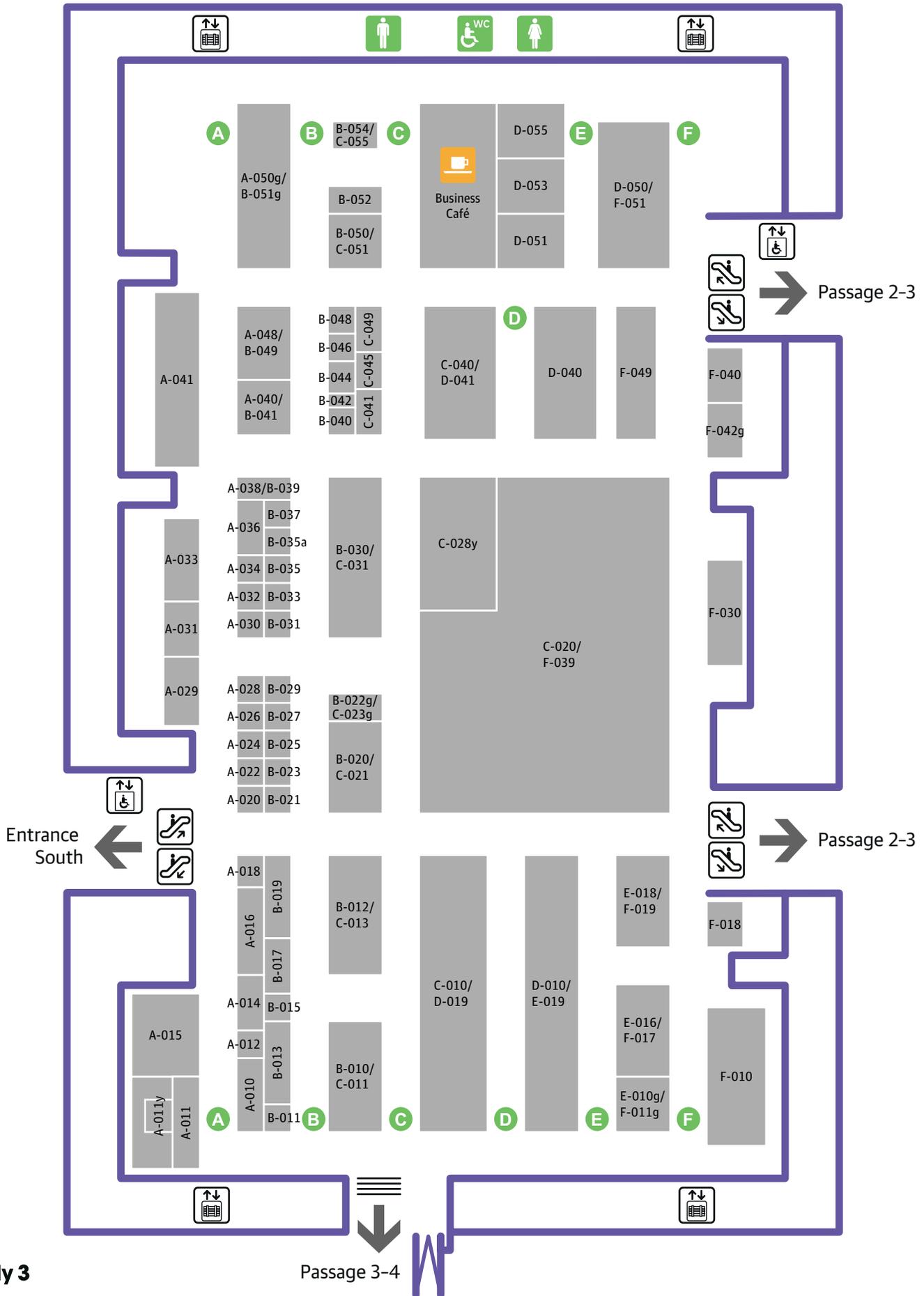

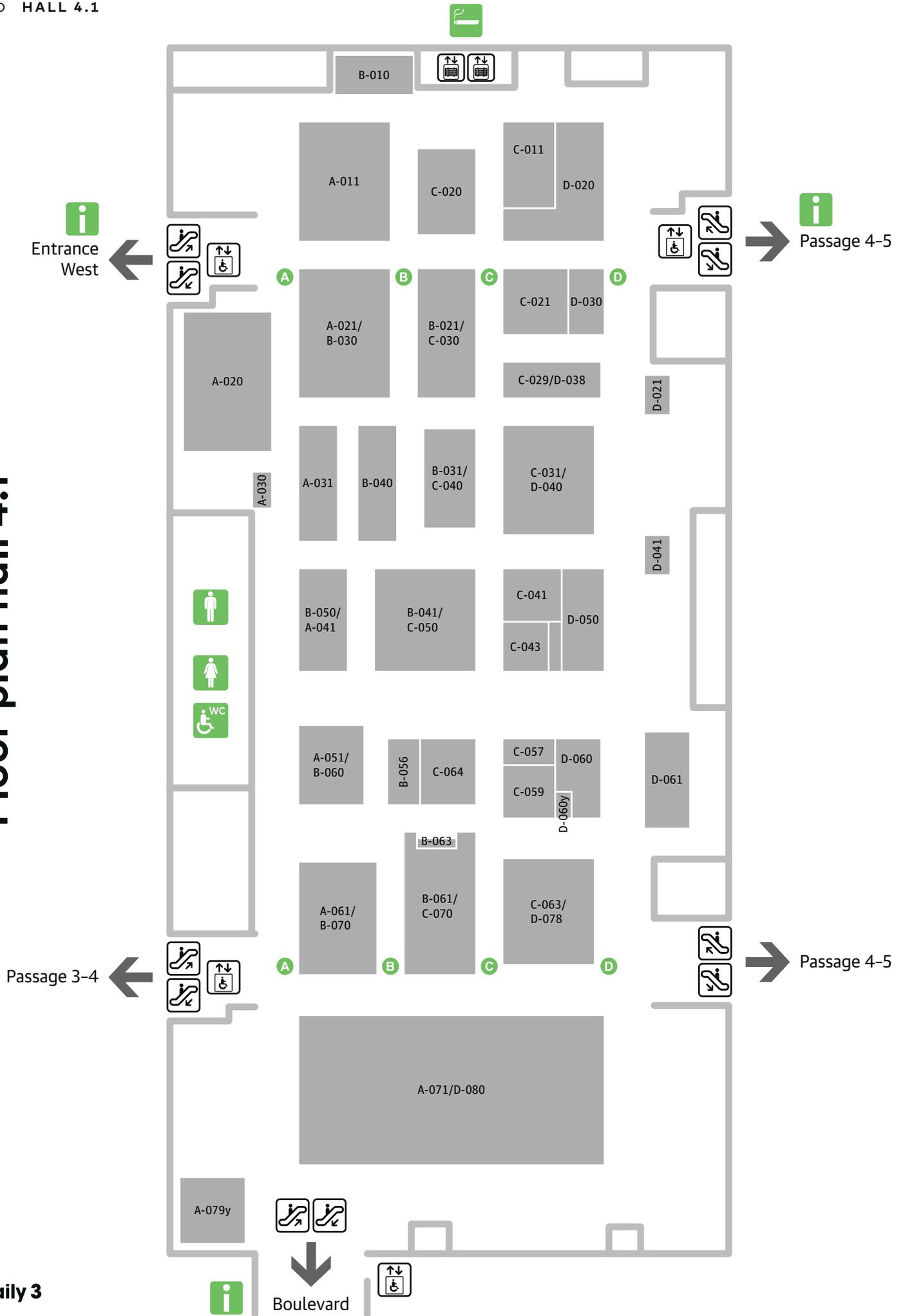
